**Consolidated Weights and Measures Act:
Order Rescinding Temporary Enforcement Policy**

Effective June 1, 2009 the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture rescinds the May 20, 2008 order titled *Temporary Enforcement Policy: Half-Gallon Pricing at Certain Retail Fuel Pumps*. This order had – on a temporary basis – prescribed a narrow set of circumstances under which a retail motor fuel dispenser could compute the price of dispensed motor fuel by the half-gallon. This was a *temporary measure* intended to afford owners of older retail motor fuel dispensers a reasonable interval within which to acquire retail motor fuel dispensers that calculate price based on whole-gallon pricing. As of June 1, 2009, the referenced temporary enforcement policy is rescinded and all retail motor fuel dispensers in commercial use within this Commonwealth shall calculate the purchase price for dispensed motor fuel on a per-gallon basis.
